Winnipeg is hosting the Canadian Junior Championships from July 25th to July 30 this year. Since the last membership fee increase in 2015, our coaching and pool fees have increased 5% and 14% respectively. Additionally our membership is down from **50** in 2015/16 to **42** in 2016/17 to **38** in 2017/18. This means we have drawn down most of the club's surplus funds. The executive will be meeting shortly to set the new rates. The new membership rates will be distributed after that. Further discussion on how to keep the club financially healthy will take place at our upcoming AGM.
